along with his parents, who really learned how to take care of him. Afterwards, the lad told his mom that he wanted to go back for another week and telling his mom that she could just stay home this time; he said that he had learned about the insulin pump and wanted to get one, going forward.

Our Fair President, Lion Charlie Childers announced facilities improvements at the fairgrounds. These included a water-proof membrane treatment for the roof and asphalt paving for the floor of the theater, installation of natural gas lines for buildings # 2, #3, & #4 as well as the concession stand, total electrical rework for RV hook-ups, primarily used by our mid-way workers during the Fair, and expansion of paving for handicapped patrons near the front gate. He announced that our Fair Queen of last year, Ms. Avery Flint, who will be a contestant in the Miss Alabama Contest this year, was also selected as a majorette for Auburn University. He also mentioned that Lion Jerry Bonner would be the coach of our Club's newly re-established polo-club and would be lining out a polo playing field in the fairground main parking area and will be trying to get some spectator bleachers to accommodate the expected crowds.

Lion President Chris Brooks read a thank-you note from Blount County for the Club's support of its 4-H calf-show at the Cullman Fairground barn facilities. He also had a thank-you note from The Little Pantry and another from Victim Services for the Club's donations, following their presentations in the last few weeks. Former Lion Jim Grear & his wife Patty dropped us a note saying that they missed us and said to keep up the good work; Jim has had medical problems the last couple of years.
