Program

Lion Secretary Don Smith spoke about exhibit restrictions for the 2020 Fair due to Covid-19 concerns. Baked Goods will not be accepted this year – thus, no Queen or King of the kitchen. We have no way of adequately protecting submitted food nor can we vouch for the conditions of the kitchen in which it was prepared. The total number of non-livestock submissions (e.g., canned goods, vegetables, art, photographs, sewing and other handicrafts) will be limited to 3 for any single exhibitor. This is consistent with the average number of items submitted in most categories. It will negatively impact our 10 or so "power submitters" who often enter more than 50 items. The other 99% of our participants will not really be affected. This policy will really assist in limiting the exposure time spent between our Lionesses and the exhibitors, reducing the probability of any disease transmission. Limiting to 3 items will greatly expedite the turn in process and minimize check in time since we also anticipate that our exhibit-staff will be shorthanded because of Covid-19 concerns.

Other Business

The Club's Board of Directors (BOD) met briefly and authorized the President to sign the City of Cullman Special Event Agreement for the 2020 Fair Parade which addresses actions to comply with Covid-19 governmental requirements; this was a necessary step in order to secure a

parade permit. There will be a regular BOD meeting next week.
