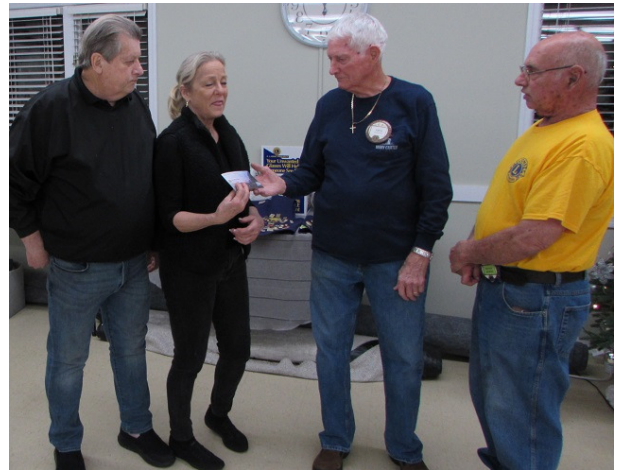
White, Carey Thompson, Jerry Bonner, Bill Ruehl, and Ron Seybold.
