Lion Jeff Lawson introduced our speaker tonight, City Police Public Relations Officer, Sgt. Adam Clark, a 25-year veteran of Cullman's Police force. His presentation to the Club focused on the Police Department's project, "Shop with a Cop."

Sgt. Clark summarized this "Shop with a Cop" program saying that each year he and volunteers from the Cullman Police Department and elsewhere take about 16 local indigent children on a shopping trip through Walmart, allowing each child to spend between \$300 and \$500 on anything they want for Christmas, clothes, toys or whatever; if a child want to get a present for a grandparent, for instance, that is taken into consideration, possibly raising the spending limit. The ages of the children can range from infant to high school age. Funds come from charitable organizations such as our Club to businesses to individuals. Recommendations for specific children to participate each year usually come from two of our local charity organizations: Margret-Jean Jones organization and Brook's Place. The has only been one instance when a child was selected more than one year. If a selected child has brothers and/or sisters, an effort is made to include all the children from that family. Families of selected children are informed, and they are advised that no presents should be returned for cash. Also, Walmart cooperates in this regard by specifically marking any receipts for this project such that any purchased items are not allowed for return. This program helps greatly with police relations within the community and provides many indigent children with an experience they will treasure for the rest of their lives.
