Although not a Lion, her husband, Darryl, has volunteered to work in the Lions Concession stand during our Fair in past years. Jolanda was a gracious last-minute replacement for our scheduled speaker, who cancelled due to illness.

Ms. Hutson began by thanking the Club for its support following her presentation last year. She then invited all Lions to attend the Clinic's next big fund-raising project, which is a concert on October 18<sup>th</sup> at 7:00PM at Cullman High School Auditorium. Tickets are \$15; Lion Steve Singleton says he will have them for sale at our next meeting on Oct. 1<sup>st</sup>. Lion Riley Smith attended last year's concert and said it was fantastic. The featured artists last year, the Triumphant Quartet, will be back again this year. The Wallace State Jazz

Band will also be playing. All branches of Cullman Savings Bank, as well as the Good Samaritan Clinic, located at the ER of the old Folsom Hospital (address 401 Arnold Street NE, Suite A) (256) 775-1389), will have tickets for sale.

Jolanda quickly covered some facts about her Clinic: The Good Samaritan Health Clinic provides free quality healthcare services to low-income, uninsured residents of Cullman County, AL. It operates as a primary care clinic, providing a full range of services and referrals to specialty physicians; it also provides most medications free of charge to its patients. It is able to coordinate care for its patients by providing them in-clinic access to numerous healthcare services. Its services do include dental X-rays and extraction of teeth. Good Samaritan does not duplicate any healthcare services that are offered for free elsewhere. If you are a resident of Cullman County without any health insurance coverage, meet certain income requirements, and are between the ages of 19 and 65 you may be eligible to receive health care services through Good Samaritan Health Clinic. Ms. Hutson advised potential patients to get qualified at the Clinic before seeking help with any medical condition because it may take a couple of days to verify that an individual meets all requirements to receive its medical assistance, which is substantial. This clinic is just another great example of an organization that provides help to those who need it most in Cullman County.
